Linköping is Sweden's fifth largest city. The city has strong traditions as a regional and county town. It's history as a modern industrial city began in 1937 when aircraft manufacturing was located to Linköping.

Linköping municipality, The County Council, Linköping University and companies such as Saab and Ericsson are examples of large employers in the city. Linköping University is one of Sweden's largest universities, with 32,000 student and 4,000 employees. In close collaboration with the business world and society, Linköping University (LiU) conducts world-leading, boundary-crossing research in fields including materials science, IT and hearingment.

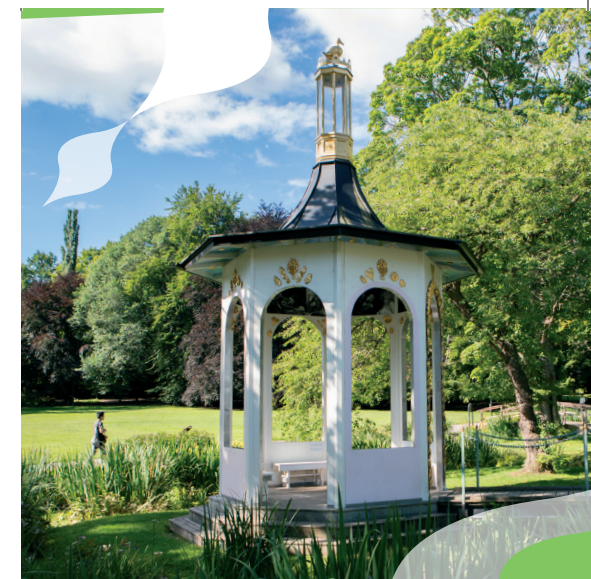
