Linköping is Sweden's fifth largest city. The city has strong traditions as a regimental and county town. It's history as a modern industrial city began in 1937 when aircraft manufacturing was located to Linköping.

Linköping municipality, The County Council, Linköping University and companies such as Saab and Ericsson are examples of large employers in the city. Linköping University is one of Sweden's largest universities. With 27,000 student and 4,000 employees and a campus in both Linköping and Norrköping the university is crucial to regional development.

Located near the university is Mjärdevi Science Park, an attractive home to 260 innovative companies employing more than 6,100 people. Mjärdevi offers a broad base of support and activities to encourage and stimulate growth and success among its companies — from start-ups to multi-nationals.

The university hospital and Linköping University has a well established cooperation in medical research and education. The hospital is currently undergoing renovation to create a hospital for the future where medical care, research and education meet in modern environments.

One of the main attractions in Linköping is the cathedral. Besides being beautiful, the cathedral is interesting in its architecture and is extremely well preserved. The city's main event venues include Saab Arena, Linköping Konsert & Kongress and Linköping Arena.
